Continuous Growth

Coming off a successful year in 2013, LA Art Show's 19th outing will feature four distinct sections of art.

The 2014 *LA Art Show* returns to the Los Angeles Convention Center, South Hall J & K, from January 15 to 19. The show, produced by the Palm Beach Show Group, is now in its 19th year and looking to build from the momentum of last year's success. In 2013 show hours were extended to accommodate the more than 50,000 collectors who visited the event, and participating galleries reported strong sales with over \$25 million in transactions being made throughout the four-day event.

To kick off this year's sale will be an Opening Night Premiere Party on January 15 from 8 to 11 p.m. Beginning at 7 p.m. will be the Patron Reception with Celebrity Art Ambassador Tim Robbins. The opening

night festivities, teaming with Sister Cities of Los Angeles, will celebrate the 50th anniversary of Los Angeles' partnership with sister city Bordeaux, France.

On display throughout the weekend will be a robust offering of art from modern, contemporary, traditional and historic dealers located around the globe. Among the participating galleries are Arcadia Contemporary, Lotton Gallery, Blue Rain Gallery, American Legacy Fine Arts, Altamira Fine Art, Richard J. Demato Fine Arts Gallery, Bonner David Galleries, Lawrence Cantor Fine Art, and Denis Bloch Fine Art.

Along with the impressive collection of galleries, there will be a roster of programming including lecture series, special exhibits by top curators,

book signings, guided show tours, mixers and evening events. The show also boasts

its unique "fair-within-a-fair" format where four distinct sections of art are found in the 180,000-square-foot hall. There will be the Modern & Contemporary section, Historic & Traditional Contemporary section, Vintage Poster section, and the LA IFPDA Print Fair.

"We have deep roots in Los Angeles and have nurtured them for nearly two decades," says Kim Martindale, the show's producer. "This is why we are LA's art show. Our foundation here is strong and our completely are experience format continues to resonate with Angelenos.
