Celebrating Five Centuries of Fine Art


It promises to be another record-breaking year for the Los Angeles Art Show, which has fast become one of the most prestigious art fairs in the country.

ow in its 13th year, the highly anticipated Los Angeles Art Show brings together over 80 distinguished international art galleries at the Barker Hangar at the Santa Monica Airport from Thursday, January 24 through Sunday, January 27, 2008.
