
Zhao Kai Lin, Listening To the Rain, Oil on Canvas, 52 x 52 Inches 2007, courtesy of the Arcadia Gallery

With more than 125 exhibitions from destinations around the globe, this highly anticipated event marks the first time that the IFPDA's Los Angeles Fine Art Print Fair joins the exhibition, further expanding the scope of the artwork on display.


The LA Art Show is one of the country's most prestigious art expositions featuring a striking array of artwork spanning cutting-edge contemporary and period works from some of the world's finest artists. The show kicks off with an exclusive opening night gala on Wednesday, January 23, from 7-10pm,

which benefits the Art Museum Council and the Prints and Drawing Council of the Los Angeles County Museum of Art (LACMA). Serving as this year's Honorary Gala Chair is the Honorable Antonio R. Villaraigosa, Mayor, City of Los Angeles. The show is open to the general public from Thursday, the 24th, through Sunday, the 27th.




